2026 T-BALL RULES

- Game time is 60 minutes with no new inning starting after 55 minutes
- Innings are 7 runs max or 3 outs
- All players can be on the field and in the lineup.
- All batters and base runners must always wear a helmet.
- Batter has five attempts to hit the ball from the tee before the batter is out.
 - If the 5th swing is foul the batter continues to bat
 - It is a foul ball if the batter swings and hits the tee
- Coaches do have the option to pitch to the batter.
 - After the coach begins pitching to the batter the batter cannot return to tee during at bat
 - 5 pitches or 3 swinging strikes
- A player cannot run the ball to first base for an out unless the ball is caught by the first baseman. (Ball must be thrown for an out at first)
 - Ball can be thrown or rolled to the first baseman for an out to be called.
 - Head coach is responsible for informing the umpire or opposite team coach of whom the first baseman is prior to the start of each inning.
- Batting teams are allowed to have a coach at each base
 - If the base coach assists the runner in any way the player is out
- If base runner leaves the field of play the runner will be out
- 2 outfield coaches are allowed on the field but must always stay behind the furthest player
- 1 infield coach is allowed on the field but must always remain in foul territory
- We will attempt to make up all weather cancelled games
- Only 3 players can play on the front arch – (Including the player in the circle)
 - All other players must be even or beyond the base lines when the ball is hit
- If a batted ball goes out the opening of the fence in left field this will be considered a ground rule double.
- The head coach is responsible for their players, assistant coaches, and their fans always.
 - No vulgar language toward the players, coaches, or umpire will be tolerated and can be an automatic ejection at the umpire's discretion.
- The umpire always has complete control of the field. No decision made by the umpire can be overruled by anyone, including the park director.
- The umpire has the authority to remove anyone from the field or vicinity including any player, coach, fan, or bystander.
 - If a person fails to leave the field after the umpire has asked the umpire has the authority to end the game
- 2026 double elimination tournament date will begin April 13th
 - Seeding for the tournament will be announced later.
